

**easyJet's Flight Paths Cabin Crew Taster Session Event  
Privacy Notice**

**1. Who is responsible for your personal data?**

For ease, when we talk about “we” or “us” or “our” or “easyJet”, we mean easyJet Airline Company Limited (**easyJet** or **We** or **Our**), a company with registered office at Hangar 89, London Luton Airport, Luton, Bedfordshire, LU2 9PF. easyJet Airline Company Limited is the Data Controllers of the Personal Data used to manage your registration and attendance to any individual attending the Event at the Pilot and Cabin Crew training experiences (the “**Event**”) taking place at the easyJet Gatwick Academy (the “**Academy**”). In this policy, We explain how We collect and use your personal data.

‘**Personal data**’ basically means any information that can be used to identify you. We are responsible for deciding how to use and collect personal data and to ensure it is handled properly in line with this notice.

This Event is available to adults only. Anyone aged under 18 years will not be allowed to participate meaning we will reject your booking and refuse access to the Academy.

**2. Personal data We collect and share about you as part of the Event**

You will need to book your ticket on the booking platform EventBrite which is not part of easyJet group and operates its booking platform and services as an independent data controller. Please read EventBrite privacy and cookie notices carefully before booking your ticket as we do not accept any responsibility or liability for data processing activities controlled by EventBrite.

We will collect and share your Personal Data will be shared within easyJet in order to manage and run the Event, and support operational, safety and legal requirements. We share some of your Personal Data with affiliate companies of the easyJet group and third-party suppliers who work on our behalf to support us as part of the Event organisation and for our promotional activities related to the Event.

We will (with your expressed permission) also take photos, recordings and videos of your attendance data to promote the Event. We use this personal This includes promoting the Event on social media, newspapers, television, or online news media.

We may also use the personal data to contact you, run Our business, and to help Us follow the law.
